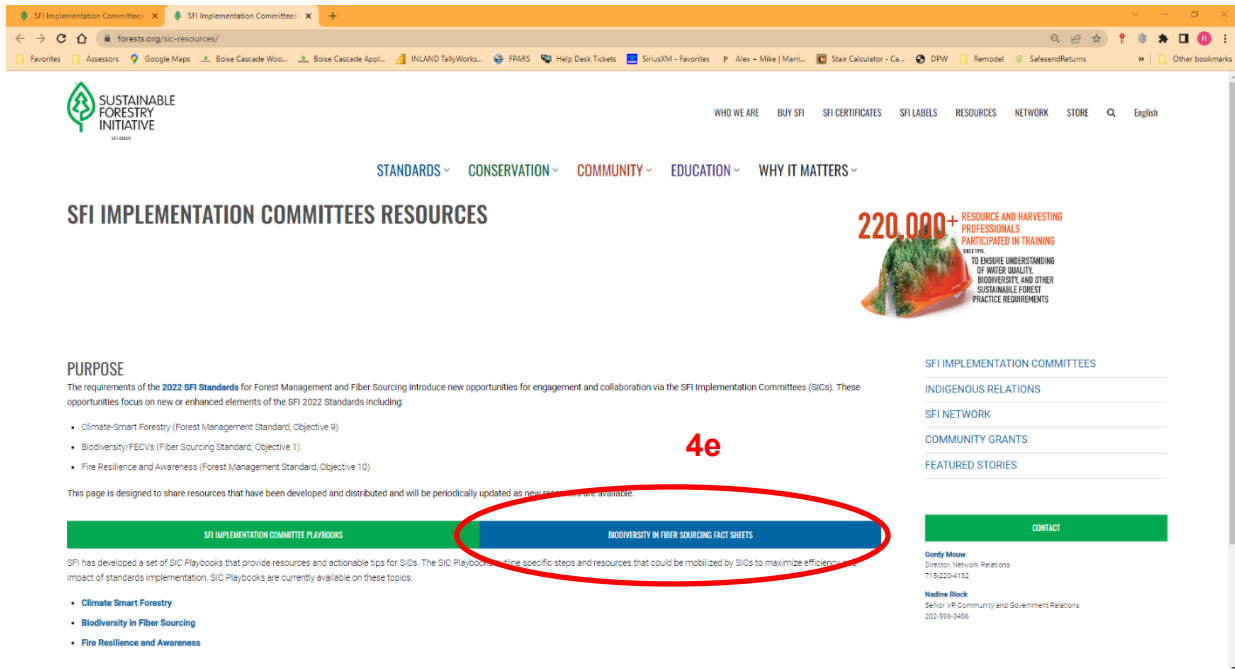
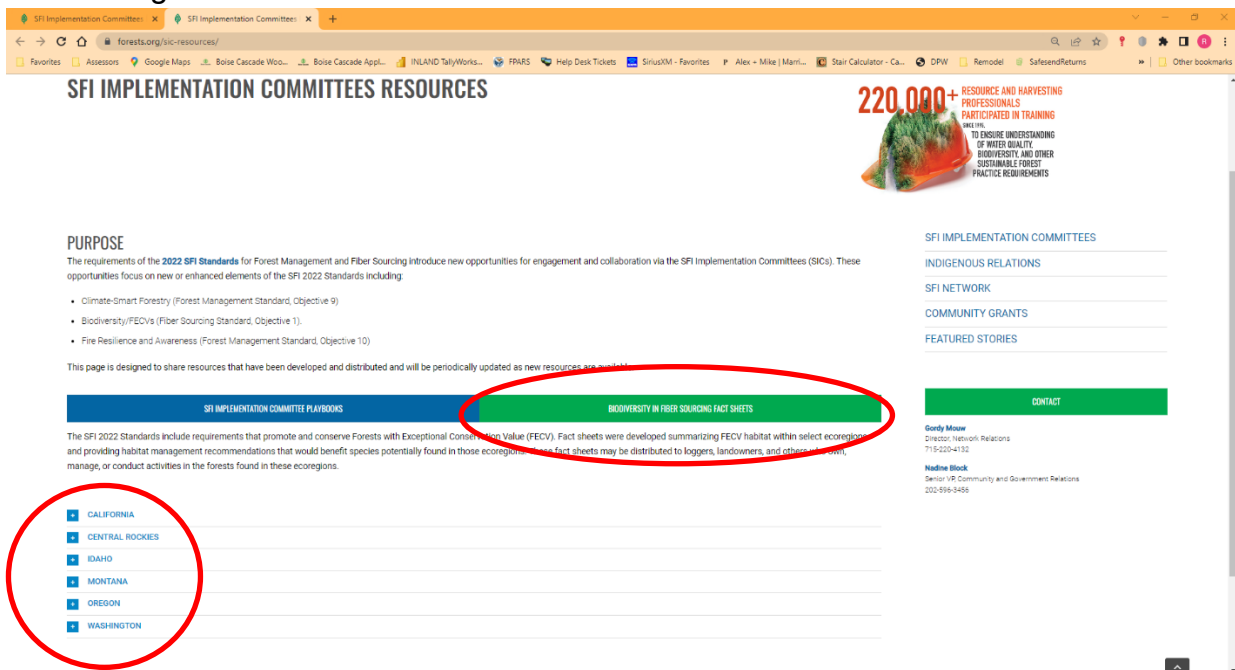


How to access “[Biodiversity In Fiber Sourcing Fact Sheets](#)” for Western States (NOTE: You will need to zoom in to enlarge image and see printing)

1. The link above will take you directly to the **SFI IMPLEMENTATION COMMITTEES RESOURCES** page. Scroll to the lower third of page and select blue box.



2. It will turn green and a list of the Western States will be available.

 - a. Open browser to SFI home page – www.forest.org
 - b. Select “**COMMUNITY**” top center of page – www.forest.org/community/
 - c. Mid page, right hand column select “**SFI IMPLEMENTATION COMMITTEES**” – www.forest.org/sic/
 - d. Right hand column below **Green/Blue** bar labeled “**DOCUMENTS/CONTACT**” select “**SIC Resources**” - www.forest.org/sic-resources/
 - e. Follow instruction in number “1” above.
